Priorities in your Area

PACT (Partners and Communities Together)

At the meeting on the 6th December 2011, it was agreed to retain the priority of

- Speeding Throughout the Bawtry/Tickhill Villages

As a result a number of high visibility patrols were carried out in these areas by local Officers, Road Traffic colleagues and Special Constables. DMBC colleagues in the Neighbourhood Response Team have supported these. In all a total of 30 patrols and 11 speed gun operations have been carried out. Regular operations are planned for 2012, which will continue to target drivers who exceed speed limits.

Was agreed at the PACT meeting on Thursday 12th January 2012. Excellent news all crime is down 62.5%. Criminal damage is down 20% and Anti Social Behaviour (ASB) is down 26.8%.

We will continue to work hard to keep reducing crime and ASB in your area.

In relation to the recent assault in Bawtry, the SNT are working closely with residents, licensed premises and the security staff employed in the nighttime economy sector to provide reassurance and a visible presence. Whilst this was a very serious offence, it should be noted that this is an isolated incident and very uncharacteristic for Bawtry. A male has since been arrested and charged in connection with the assault.

- Auckley Christmas Market at the Village Green on 13th December 2011 was a success and attracted over 1,000 visitors

Operations / Projects / Good News

- A new play park has been installed during December 2011 on Auckley Parish Council land off Ravenswood Drive, know as Riverside Park. The project was part funded from section 106 monies from the Dursley Court development and by the Parish Council.
- Area Officers are proactively undertaking “fly tipping” patrols in key hotspots locations across Torne Valley in our zero tolerance approach to this offence. Offenders risk prosecutions.
- A “horse friendly “ gate to prevent access to motor vehicles and motor cycles has been installed on Low Common Lane, Austerfield in response to numerous concerns being raised by the Parish Council and residents about ASB and perceived drug related activity in this area.
- Doncaster Rover’s tickets on a regular basis to area teams – Torne Valley received 30 tickets in December, which were given to the Wadworth TARA and Local Schools.
- Stainton pond and the surrounding area has had a tidy up and litter pick undertaken by the area team as a result of requests received form the Parish Council and local residents. The team are hoping to get local volunteers to participate in this project when it is repeated in a few months.
