


-  **Green Bin collection day** Please DO NOT BAG WASTE and DO NOT USE BIN LINERS OR SACKS with your green bin.
-  **Black Bin collection day** Your bin lid should be closed. No additional bags of waste should be left next to your bin.
-  **Bank Holidays** In weeks with a Bank Holiday your collection day will be one day later than usual. For example, if your collection day is usually Wednesday, it will be Thursday following the Bank Holiday. Check your bin sticker for details.
-  **No collections** There will be **NO COLLECTIONS** on 27, 28, 29, 30 or 31 December. Your black and green week pattern will also change over the Christmas period so please refer to this calendar.

### On your bin collection day

- Please put out your green box and recycling sacks - these will be emptied every week.
- Please make sure that your bin, box and sacks are put out at the edge of your property by 7.30am and taken in when emptied.
- If your bin or box is not emptied by 5pm on your collection day, please report it to us within two days by calling 01302 736000.

# Please keep recycling for a cleaner, greener Doncaster!

Recycling rates in Doncaster have continued to rise and in 2009/10 the recycling rate was 39.6%. In the same year almost 23,000 tonnes of green waste was collected at your kerbside and composted. You also helped to recycle over 18,800 tonnes of paper, glass, metal cans, textiles and plastic bottles by using your green box and recycling bags.



## Did you know?

You can recycle textiles, clothes, shoes, mobile phones, printer cartridges, aerosols and foil in your green box.

Extra cardboard can be stacked under your green box if needed.

## What goes where?



### Green Bin

Garden waste such as leaves, twigs and grass cuttings



### Green Box

Recycling such as tins, cans, aerosols, glass bottles and jars, and cardboard



### Blue Sack

Paper



### Clear Sack

Plastic bottles

## Did you know?

You should not use black bin liners for your recycling. If you can't fit all of your recycling into your box, you can request additional boxes and sacks - please call Doncaster Council on 01302 736000.

You can request a lid for your box on the same number.

## How to get rid of your bulky waste

### Household Waste Recycling Centres

Doncaster has six centres:

- Armthorpe, Armthorpe Road
- Balby, Springwell Lane
- Carcroft, Bentley Moor Lane
- Conisbrough, Crookhill Road
- Hatfield, Bootham Lane
- Rossington, Bankwood Lane

### Bulky items such as unwanted furniture or appliances

You can place an order with the council to have your bulky waste items collected from your house by Doncaster Refurnish and disposed of safely and legally.

### Paying someone to take away your bulky waste

By law, anyone you pay to take away your waste should be a registered waste carrier with a waste carrier's license.

Dishonest contractors charge to dispose of your rubbish at a registered site, but instead, fly-tip it. If fly-tipped rubbish is traced back to you, then you could be fined up to £5000.
